

# Dundee Township East Cemetery Columbaria Garden

Started in 1890, the Dundee Township East Cemetery is located in East Dundee at the corner of Route 72 and Route 25. The cemetery has 51 acres of gently rolling land. The cemetery offers a variety of burial options including its' new Columbaria Garden that provides an above ground option for the interment of cremated remains. The Columbaria Garden is set in a prairie with native trees and plants making it a tranquil area.

The Columbaria Garden offers two options for the inurnment of remains. The unit has 94 niches which are designed to accommodate one or two urns.

The Columbaria also has an Ossuarium in its' center that is a common resting place for cremated remains.

The Columbaria Garden is designed so that as the spaces in the first unit are purchased, an additional unit will be installed on the adjacent foundation.

## Services and Pricing


### Pricing

Pricing for the purchase of one of the Columbaria Niches starts at \$1,825.00 for Dundee Township residents. This price includes the perpetual right to the niche, the inurnment of up to two urns, and the standard engraving of the cover plate. Additional fees will apply for non-residents and for other services such as weekend inurnments.

Pricing for the inurnment in the Ossuarium begins at \$400.00 for Dundee Township residents. The pricing includes the standard engraving on the memorial band. Again, additional fees will apply to non-residents and for other services.

### Engraving



The above sample shows the standard engraving for the Niche covers. The engraving is limited to the deceased name, birth year and year of death. A standard symbol may be added at an additional charge.

### Niches



Each niche will accommodate up to two (2) standard 10" high cremation urns. Cremains may also be placed in the niche using any standard container. The cemetery reserves the right to refuse to accept any urn/container that is not determined to be non-durable or that will not fit into the niche.

After the cremains are placed into the niche, the niche is sealed with a stainless steel plate and then covered with a matching granite cover. The niche can be reopened to add an additional urn or to remove an urn should that be necessary.

## Ossuarium

The Columbaria Garden at the East Dundee Cemetery also offers an Ossuarium option for the inurnment of cremains. The Ossuarium is a large common niche that can hold up to 400 sets of cremains. The cremains (in the sealed container/bag from the crematorium) are placed into a velvet bag and then placed into the common niche.

The individuals interred in the Ossuarium are memorized on a special band as shown below:



The standard fee for inurnment in the Ossuarium is \$400.00 which includes the opening fee and the standard engraving on the memorial band. (The price quoted is for Dundee Township Residents - please contact our Cemetery Manager for non-resident pricing.)

**IMPORTANT:** Once cremains are inurned in the Ossuarium, they can NOT be removed - This type of inurnment is permanent.

## Cost Analysis

The interment of cremains in the Columbaria is an economical alternative to interring the cremains in ground.

The inground option includes:

a. Purchase of Cremation Lot	\$ 450
b. Grave Opening Fee	\$ 400
c. Purchase of Marker (Estimated)	<u>\$ 2,000</u>
<b>Total Costs</b>	<b>\$ 2,850</b>

A niche in the Columbaria Garden is priced at \$1,825. This price includes the opening fee and the cost of standard engraving for the niche cover.
