

Dundee Township Highway Department

PERMITS:

- Any work done in the road right-of-way has to be cleared through the Highway Commissioner.
- Any business or utility company doing work in the road right-of-way needs a permit issued by the Highway Commissioner.
- Any new access has to go through the Highway Department for a permit.
- A permit is required by both the county and township for any culvert or drain tile in the ditch line.

DRAINAGE:

Most storm water drainage in the Township is accomplished using open ditches which run parallel to the road. Most every driveway has a culvert pipe installed beneath it.

If you have any problems with water drainage in your area, please feel free to contact our office.

SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL:

Dundee Township begins plowing and salting the roadways when the streets begin to be snow covered. For ice control we start salting immediately.

We do not intentionally plow in your driveways or try to knock down your mail boxes. It is a violation of Illinois Law to plow, push, blow or in any way place snow upon a public road.

MAILBOXES:

Occasionally a snowplow will knock down a mailbox. If this happens the Township will replace the mailbox with a standard mailbox and 4 x 4 wood post.

The Postal Service guidelines apply to the installation of a rural style mailbox on a post in front of your home.

Bottom of Mailbox - 42" above the ground

Front of Mailbox - 12" in from the back of the curb or edge of road
